

This program is designed to provide short-term emergency type assistance to persons lacking the resources to meet their basic needs. This program is not intended to provide ongoing, long-term aid to any individuals and/ or family. Persons seeking assistance must complete an application and must meet eligibility requirements as outlined in Kossuth County Relief Guidelines No. VII-II Title: A Guideline. Persons seeking emergency medical care must notify the office the next working day in order for notice to be considered timely.
